## January 2020 Release <br> Overview of Key Changes

The January 26, 2020 price change will impact all mail
classes. The major changes for this release are
summarized below.

## JANUARY 2020 PRICE CHANGE UPDATES:

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## SEAMLESS ACCEPTANCE PERMIT SIMPLIFICATION

Annual presort fees will be deferred for any permit during the time it is used in a Seamless mailing. When a permit is used in a Seamless mailing, fees are deferred. When a permit is used in a non-Seamless mailing, fees will be due when applicable.

These changes will affect Market Dominant products only and will require no changes to Postage Statements, Mail.dat or Mail.XML.

## FULL-SERVICE FEE WAIVER CALCULATION CHANGE

Calculation of the Full-Service fee will be revised so that payment of the fee will be deferred as long as the following requirements are met:75\% of total submitted mail volume is Full-Service eligible$90 \%$ of the Full-Service-eligible volume is presented as Full-Service

This is a change from the current Full-Service fee calculation which requires that $\mathbf{9 0 \%}$ of presort-eligible mail be presented as Full-Service. This update will not require any changes to postage statements, Mail.dat or Mail.XML.

## DIMENSIONAL WEIGHT CALCULATION ADDED TO RETAIL GROUND MAIL

USPS will implement dimensional weight pricing for USPS Retail Ground mail. A dimensional divisor of 166 will be established for packages with dimensions greater than one cubic foot ( 1,728 inches). The update will be implemented for all Zones 1-9. Balloon pricing will be removed for USPS Retail Ground. Oversized pricing (and structure) will remain in place. USPS Retail Ground Limited Overland Routes (LOR) will not adopt dimensional weighting. The current Balloon and Oversize structure and pricing will remain unchanged for LOR.

## NEW FEE FOR UN-MANIFESTED EVS PACKAGES

USPS will implement an un-manifested eVS fee, designed to encourage manifesting of all packages. Accurate electronic manifesting is important to both mailers and the Postal Service because it provides important data on packages, including pricing elements that enable accurate, timely, payment of packages. The un-manifested eVS fee will be assessed when un-manifested volume exceeds the initial established threshold of $4 \%$ of mailer's entire manifested volume as calculated by the Un-manifested Fee formula. The un-manifested ratio is a percentage derived from taking the total un-manifested volume by mail class and dividing it by the total manifested volume by mail class plus the number of manifested error pieces within the mail class reported for a mailing month. Un-manifested pieces above the threshold are charged a $\$ 0.20$ per piece fee. Un-manifested pieces below the threshold are not changed and the IMpb compliance assessment will be unchanged. Un-manifest fee assessed packages are not subject to Intelligent Mail package barcode ( IMpb ) compliance fees. The un-manifested fee is calculated by multiplying the number of pieces over the threshold by $\$ 0.20$. Packages assessed this charge will not be assessed an IMpb compliance fee, when applicable.


Mailers can now upload one or more PDF sample mailpieces for a given promotion through the BCG Incentive Module. Currently, mailpiece samples are required to be left with the BMEU, which in turn mails the sample mailpieces to the USPS Program Office. When uploading multiple PDF files, the files will be grouped and given a unique Mailpiece Sample Group ID which can be linked to the postage statements claiming the promotion discount. When no electronic sample file is linked to the postage statement in PostalOne!, mailers will receive a reminder message to present a physical sample to the BMEU at the time of mail acceptance. Mailers logged into BCG Incentive Module will be able to click the 'Email Us' button on the "BCG > Incentive > Program Assistance" page to communicate directly to the Promotions Program Office. The current, online Form used to communicate to Program Office will be replaced with the email address information for Promotions Program Office.

## ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION OF PS FORM 3510

The Business Customer Gateway (BCG) Postal Wizard will be updated to enable users to electronically submit PS Form 3510, Application for Re-entry or Special Price Request for Periodicals Publication. The form will be available in the BCG Postal Wizard in the section labeled Complete Customer Service Form.


At the completion and submission of the online form, users are notified that they must submit all required documentation to their local BMEU within 30 days. Required documentation can be presented in person or mailed to the BMEU.

The Application Payment page in PostalOne! allows customers to pay their non-refundable Re-Entry fee from their EPS account or through local post office.
